
What is LIFE EX-TRA?

- A joint initiative of organizations from Italy, Romania, Bulgaria and Greece.
- The coordinating institution is PNGSL Parco Nazionale Gran Sasso e Monte della Laga (Italy) and partners are public institutions, national parks, universities and NGOs from 4 countries.
- In Romania, the project partner organization is Transilvania University of Brasov, Faculty of Silviculture and Forest Engineering.
- The project aims to improve the know-how of conservation actors in what concerns activities for the **conservation of wolves and bears.**
- It foresees to improve the capacities of all participants about essential aspects of carnivore conservation: biological aspects, interactions with other species, conflict management and stakeholder involvement.
- The project shall also provide the acquisition of **best practices** by all the project participants, apart from the ones gained in the **LIFE COEX Project**.









- The activities are carried out in 3 different project areas:
- Herculian Cormos (Covasna county) – a Natura 2000 site designated for large carnivores
- Dalnic (Covasna county) high densities of LC and intensive livestock grazing activities
- Sacele (Brasov county) part of the area included in two Natura 2000 sites







- Training management actors from project areas in Brasov and Covasna counties.
- Understanding needs and expectations of stakeholders from the 3 project areas.
- Involving stakeholders in decision making processes.









- Donation of LGD livestock guarding dogs.
- Promoting communication between dog breeders and livestock breeders.
- Development of damage monitoring strategies that involves all the actors.









- Development of bear emergency team BET (transfer of expertise from IUCN BSG – Bear Specialists Group).
- Strengthening of wild prey populations (Poaching Control, Improving Food Conditions, Field Monitoring of Prey Species).
- Public awareness campaigns for the general public and information campaigns for the interest groups in ways of coexistence.
- Creation of a discussion platform for management actors. Exchanges of experience for management actors.
- Transfer of best practices between project participants. Design of best-practice manuals for project participants and for management actors.
